

Amendment to Stonham Aspal Parish Council Standing Orders 21st April 2020

3. Meetings Generally

Addition of point

- y. The Local Authorities and Police and Crime Panels (Coronavirus) (Flexibility of Local Authority and Police and Crime Panel Meetings) (England and Wales) Regulations 2020 (“the 2020 Regulations”) come in to force on 4 April and applies to all Local Council Meetings (but not Parish Meetings) until 7th May 2021 unless otherwise changed by Government.
 - i. This regulation allows Local Council meetings to be held remotely.
 - ii. Notices of remote meetings will be posted on the Councils Website in line with normal notice periods
 - iii. Meetings are open to members of the public and access details will be published online alongside the agenda. Participants will need to register an email address before being able to access the meeting. Details on how to register an email address will be posted on the Parish Council website. All registration requests must be received at least 2 hours before the meeting is due to start. Members of the public are responsible for arranging their own remote access, technical support will not be given by the Parish Council as a matter of course.
 - iv. Documents associated with the meeting will be posted on the Parish Council website where public access to them is required.
 - v. Voting at a remote meeting will take place by each member present verbally stating their vote in turn.
